ASSISTANT CABIN LEADER

AGES 15+

- Reports to Section Heads and assists lead Cabin Leader
- faithful witness of Jesus Christ in word and action
- Cultivate spiritual growth within the cabin group through daily prayer, daily cabin devotions, and continual lifestyle example.
- Attend chapel sessions with your campers and be prepared to discuss the Biblical principles with campers and other staff.
- Attend staff meetings and prayer times.
- ensure and maintain the safety, to the best of their ability, of every camper in their cabin group. This includes knowing where every camper is at all times.
- Lead or assist in the implementing of morning activities
- Create cabin activities for use during cabin times or 'down' times for their cabin group.
- Follow guidelines outlined in the MBC volunteer handbook.
- Ensure entire cabin group is punctual for all camp activities
- Keep cabin area clean and neat at all times.
- Strives to build and maintain strong team relationships
- Commits to what needs to be done to show the campers the most amazing summer camp experience.

HOUSEKEEPING/ MAINTENANCE TEAM

AGES 15+

- Reports to Assistant Program Director
- Daily cleaning list to include boys' and girl's washrooms, Longhouse after each meal, (mopping at least once per week), Longhouse washrooms,
- Assist with program setup as directed
- Lifeguard duties as required for safe program (if qualified)
- maintain the work area in a manner which is safe, tidy and clean
- develop a Christ-like, servant atmosphere in his/her work area.
- Strives to build and maintain strong team relationships
- Complies with the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Policy by being aware of your responsibilities and acting accordingly; working in the safest possible manner.

KITCHEN ASSISTANT

AGES 15+

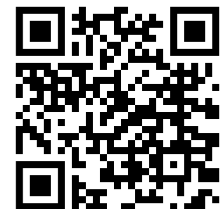
- Reports to Head Cook
- clean, store, and handle pots, utensils, dishes and cutlery following the Health Department regulations and kitchen standards.
- maintain the work area in a manner which is safe, tidy and clean
- General cleaning of kitchen and related areas.
- assist cooks in basic food preparation.
- assist in the setting and cleaning of tables and the serving of meals
- to develop a Christ-like, servant atmosphere in his/her work area.
- Receiving of goods including loading/unloading of deliveries
- Willingness to learn in a fast-paced environment
- Complies with the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Policy by being aware of your responsibilities and acting accordingly; working in the safest possible manner,
- Maintains a safe and clean facilities environment by developing, enforcing and complying with procedures, rules and regulations,
